Project Snapshot

Three Homes. Three Families. One Stronger South Shore.

In 2026, Habitat for Humanity Nova Scotia will build three new 3-bedroom homes across the South Shore — two in Liverpool and one in Bridgewater. These homes will create a pathway to safe, stable and affordable homeownership for three local families, providing a foundation for greater security, opportunity and belonging.

At a Glance

- Three new 3-bedroom homes
 - One duplex in Liverpool
 - One home in Bridgewater
- Construction begins summer 2026
- Anticipated completion by early 2027

Your support helps fund the critical stages of construction—from site preparation and excavation to foundations, structural work, labour, and essential building materials. This premier level offers the opportunity to make a transformational investment in affordable homeownership while demonstrating leadership in building stronger communities across Nova Scotia.

Major Build Partners

Investment: \$20,000–\$30,000 project-wide contributions. (per home opportunities available from \$7,500)

Major Build Partners help transform a house into a home by supporting the key systems and finishes that make each build complete. Contributions at this level may fund kitchens, bathrooms, roofing, electrical, plumbing, insulation, windows, flooring, landscaping, project management, and other essential construction components. Your partnership creates lasting impact while showcasing your organization's commitment to safe, affordable housing for local families.

Investment: \$5,000–\$15,000 project-wide contributions. (per home opportunities available from \$3,500)

Supporting Build Partners make a meaningful contribution to the finishing touches that help families move into a place they can proudly call home. 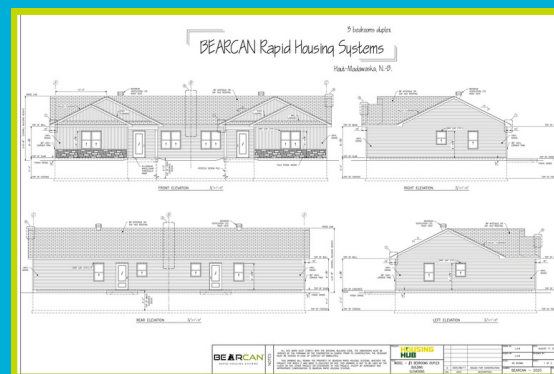
